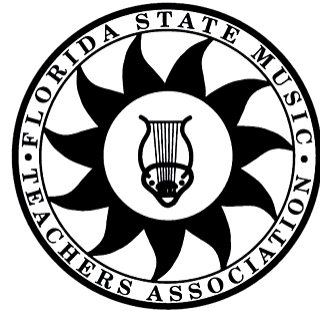


FSMTA District 3 Student Day March 2, 2019



Student Day is a non-competitive statewide evaluation program developed by FSMTA to provide structured development in the areas of performance, technique, general musicianship, and written and aural theory. Levels of difficulty range from Primary through Level 12.

Date and Place

District 3 Student Day will be held on Saturday, March 2, 2019 at the University of Florida School of Music. Entry deadline is Thursday, January 31, 2019.

Fees \$10 per studio plus
\$20 per student in Level 0
\$25 per student in Levels 1-12

Requirements and Sample Tests

Registering for Student Day

Step 1: Pay FSMTA membership dues prior to January 31, 2019.

First-time participants: If you are new to this event, please contact Karen Schaefer (352.376.0079) at sekaren2@msn.com to receive a teacher number.

Step 2: Review the Student Day guidelines in the Student Activities Handbook.

Step 3: Submit student information in the body of an email to Karen Schaefer at sekaren2@msn.com by January 31, 2019.

List students single-spaced *by level* beginning with primary.
Please type one line for each student entry that includes (in this order)

- Teacher number, student's last name, first name, instrument, level, fee, am or pm
Example: 2,Smith,Mary,piano,6,\$25

Do *not* add a space after the commas.
Indicate am or pm only if the student has a scheduling conflict.
Single-space the list of students. Do not double-space.

Step 4: Complete one Interactive Adjudication Sheet for EACH student.
(Adjudication Sheets may be found at www.fmta.org under Student Activities.)
Do not mark your teacher number on the form.
Compile forms alphabetically within each level.

Step 5: Send one check payable to FSMTA, District 3, and the completed forms to Karen Schaefer, 1619 NW 19th Circle, Gainesville, FL 32605.
Postmark deadline is January 31, 2019.

Assisting with Student Day

For Student Day to be successful, we request the help of all participating teachers. Teachers with registered students need to be available the entire day. Each teacher will receive a job assignment along with the audition schedule.

Getting the results

Results will be emailed to teachers following Student Day. Graded exams and certificates may be picked up at Student Day, or at the Honors Recital, or the following week at the home of Roxanne Godwin (3311 NW 27th Terrace). Out of town teachers may receive the exams via postal mail from Roxanne Godwin by providing a self-addressed 10" by 13" envelope with \$3.00 postage.

Awards

- I. Medals are awarded by FSMTA to students who meet the following criteria:
 - Achieving Honors (90%) in the performance audition (in skills, repertoire, and musicianship) and passing both written and aural theory (70%).

OR

 - Achieving Honors (90% or above) in the Dual Track portion in either Theory Only or Performance Only (piano, level 7 and above, or voice, level 5 and above).

- II. A trophy is awarded by GMTA to students who pass all portions of the exam.
- III. A plaque is awarded by FSMTA to students who pass level 12.

Minimum passing scores:

- Performance audition (70%)
- Written Theory (70%)
- Aural Theory (70%)

Teachers will be notified when medals and trophies are available. Trophies may be picked up at The Trophy Shop (707 NW 13th Street).

Honors Recital

Students chosen by the judges will perform on the Honors Recital. Teachers of those selected will be notified within one day after selection.

Note: Students selected for the Honors Recital must pass written and aural theory (minimum 70%) and receive Honors (minimum 90%) in the performance audition (in skills, repertoire, and musicianship).
